<p>Problem solving, Science and Maths</p> 	<p>Research how far it is from Earth to each planet (in km) and present your data in a bar chart.</p>	<p>Create a moon diary. Look at the moon throughout the week and draw what it looks like every night. How and why does it change?</p>	<p>Research the coins used in the Victorian Era and compare their value to the coins we use today.</p>	<p>During the Victorian Era, many inventions were created. Research about the inventor Alexander Graham Bell.</p>
<p>Art and Design</p> 	<p>Research the Tudor Rose and create your own. You can choose your own materials.</p>	<p>Design your own Victorian themed board game.</p>	<p>Research the features of Victorian streets/houses. Use perspective to sketch your own Victorian Street.</p>	<p>Design your own Victorian School. Create your own rules.</p>
