Write at least one side of A4 on what they said, along with your own thoughts.</p>	<p>Choose two battles in WWII and explain what happened there to make them significant.</p>	<p>Find the diary of a soldier from WWII and read a few pages, note what you find out.</p>
<p>Problem solving, Science and Maths</p> 	<p>Find the exact dates of WWII. How long ago was this? How long did the war last for?</p>	<p>What inventions were made as a result of WWII? Give dates and background information to the inventions. Can you create any?</p>	<p>Conduct an experiment to test the best material to make a soldier's helmet.</p>	<p>Investigate how many people died in WWII. What percentage of the population was this? Can you find any key statistics from WWII?</p>
<p>Art and Design</p> 	<p>Design a new logo for the Allies. Explain why you have chosen your design.</p>	<p>Create a game that teaches children a few facts about WWII. Write down the rules!</p>	<p>Create your own propaganda poster for the Allies or the Axis. Show us some of the key features .</p>	<p>Look at paintings which depict WWII; can you create your own?</p>
<p>Constructing and Creating</p> 	<p>Make a small scene that shows the D-Day landings in Normandy.</p>	<p>Glenn Miller was a popular jazz composer in the 1940's. Find out 5 pieces he wrote and look at the instruments he wrote them for. Can you create one of these?</p>	<p>Can you grow vegetables in your own Dig for Victory garden? Bring them in to share with the class if you wish or bring photos in of them for us to admire!</p>	<p>Create a model of an air raid shelter.</p>
