What our school does...

Anybody who works at our school will be checked by the DBS to make sure that they are safe to work with children.

Our school has five Designated Leads for Safeguarding, who have had lots of training to identify what to do if there is any concerns and they train all of our teachers.

Our school has an electronic sign in system and locks on the external doors and gates.

Our school teaches us how to keep ourselves safe. Our lessons include, healthy eating, anti-bullying, online safety, road safety, fire safety, water safety and how to report abuse/concerns if we are worried about our safety.



What our parents do...



Parents are one of the most important people to keep us safe they should:

- Talk to school if they need help or support.

- Let school know if there is any change in circumstance such as house move, new contact details, change of name, change of parental responsibility.
- Let school know who will be dropping off and picking up or of any additional changes to arrangements.
- Ensure the school has two contact numbers for their child
